There is no such thing as an “Old Europe”. Europe is older than America, and any white American who wishes to educate and cultivate himself as to his own history, background and race must refer to Europe for culture. To shun Europe is to turn your back on yourself. American has its heritage, has a little bit of history, and has its own culture, but it has no real culture, that is, it is not cultured, especially south of the US border. Travel is the way all peoples become cultured, coupled with the passage of time, and the isolated geographical position of the United States impedes this process. Nevertheless, it is a process that must be undertaken in order to learn true civility and culture.

The United States is a nation of 300 million inhabitants. It is the most highly technologically advanced nation of the planet, and people have come to its shores from the whole planet for 200 years. They have established the best universities the world has to offer, and through these, coupled with the promise of the American dream, have attracted the worlds most talented and promising individuals for centuries. Americans do indeed travel abroad, and a European pilgrimage is a must for all American families of European descent, at least once in their lifetimes. American college students often do semesters abroad, or simply take time to go see the world during their studies, before they begin their life of labor. Yet, by virtue of being Americans, a country with now proper culture of its own, they are denied the true cultural instruction of the world.

Asian Americans must refer to their ancient cultures, African Americans and mestizos really are left in the dark due to lack of historical sources that may shed light on their development through the ages. By the same token, African Americans and mestizos are a mixed-race peoples, and therefore there is no one culture that may elucidate for them who their people are. In America, civilization was found, but overzealous conquerors destroyed it to a great degree, in many different ways. In Africa, there is simply a lack of history due to the living conditions of the natives, and the lack of a written history, outside of Ethiopia, for the same reason above mentioned. Even so, a

verbal tradition was kept, but the disturbance of modern existence has interrupted its proper inheritance in the last few centuries of conquer and plunder.

The West has been the world leader in most political, military and spiritual matters since the discovery of the Americas over 500 years ago. To the victor go the spoils. It is a power game, and the game of power is one of perpetuation. That is, once you acquire power, your task becomes to retain it. To this effect, you stoop to any and all known methods. Psychological demoralization of vanquished opponents must become a priority, or you expose yourself to immediate retribution.

Americans are not evil, nor Europeans. They merely play games in which a loser must result. Game theory. But the rigors of game theory mean that, as a model, it will never meet all demands.
